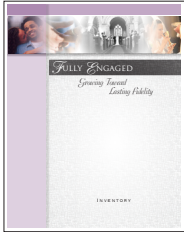


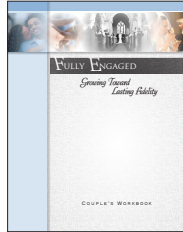
# MATERIALS

## FULLY ENGAGED INVENTORY

The Fully Engaged inventory consists of 159 statements to assist engaged couples in their reflection and discussions as they prepare for the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony. It is customizable for those marrying someone of another faith tradition, entering a second marriage and/or bringing children into the marriage. The inventory can be taken online or in a paper/pencil format.



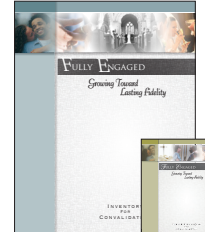
## FULLY ENGAGED COUPLE'S WORKBOOK

The Couple's Workbook is given to each individual to help them reflect on important topics prior to meeting with their facilitator(s). It provides concise catechetical information, an opportunity for prayer, and reflection questions. This resource is integrated into the discussion of the couple's individualized inventory results.



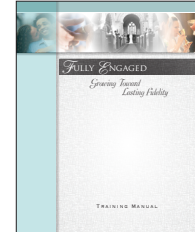
## FULLY ENGAGED FACILITATOR'S GUIDE

The Facilitator's Guide offers a step-by-step approach to assist facilitators in leading discussions with engaged couples. It includes questions to foster discussion, correlations to reflection questions in the Couple's Workbook, ideas for homework, and pertinent quotes from Church documents, Holy Scripture and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. A separate set of pages is available for the Convalidation inventory.



## FULLY ENGAGED CONVALIDATION

A separate inventory was developed for couples approaching the Church who are currently civilly married. The Convalidation inventory not only prepares couples for the sacrament but serves as a marriage enrichment tool. Greater emphasis is placed on the difference between civil and sacramental marriage; it also features an enhanced section on Catholic parenting. A Couple's Workbook for couples seeking Convalidation accompanies this inventory.



## FULLY ENGAGED TRAINING MANUAL

The step-by-step Training Manual leads a trainer through PowerPoint slides (included with the manual), and offers tips and ideas to enhance the training of mentor couples. Included in the PowerPoint are video clips of actual mentor couple/engaged couple sessions in order to foster discussion. In addition, DVDs of a training are available.

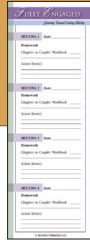
## FULLY ENGAGED SUPPLEMENTS

To customize the inventory to the special areas of concern for the engaged couples, we have developed three optional supplemental handouts.

## FULLY ENGAGED COUPLE'S HOMEWORK BOOKMARK

The Fully Engaged Program is designed for couples to read and reflect on topical areas before they are discussed.

A bookmark was created for the couple to log the date and time of their meetings with their facilitator(s), the chapters in the Fully Engaged Couple's Workbook they are to read, as well as any additional questions they should consider or reading material offered.

The Bookmarks can be ordered with the Couple's Workbooks or are included in the packet the couple receives if the Couple's Workbook is sent to them by *Fully Engaged*.



## FULLY ENGAGED EMAILS TO NEWLYWEDS

After the couple is married, they will automatically receive a monthly series of emails for the first year of their marriage. The topical areas covered are:
